Under TMEP §1610, Pure Fishing, Inc. hereby submits: (a) a certified copy of the Final Judgment of the Northern District of Illinois dated October 4, 2006 cancelling "each of the a collection of trademark registrations for STEALTH and STEALTH formatives (Exhibit 1) and (b) a copy of the order and certified copy of the mandate from the 7th Circuit Court of Appeals dismissing the appeal from the October 4, 2006 Final Judgment for want of prosecution. (Exhibit 2)

The Final Judgment cancels all of the STEALTH trademark registrations listed in the Complaint. Enclosed is a copy of the original Complaint (Exhibit 3) and the Amended Complaint (Exhibit 4) that was filed on May 26, 2005. 
